This test is to be done at a swimming pool under the supervision of a Red Cross certified lifeguard while wearing attire suitable for rowing (no shoes).

Swim/Tread Water *Test* Requirements:

- Swim 100 yards unassisted without touching the floor of the pool (no time limit).
- Tread water unassisted for 10 minutes.

- Contact swimming pool convenient to you to schedule time to do the *Test* when a certified lifeguard is on duty.
- Check-in with lifeguard and ask them to supervise the *Test*.
- Have the lifeguard complete PART B and sign the form below.
- Upon completion of PARTS A and B return this form to OAR Membership Chair.
